The Torch Run is an actual running event in which officers and athletes run the "Flame of Hope" to the Celebration Ceremonies of Special Olympics competitions. The Torch Run is also a diverse initiative encompassing a variety of fundraisers, including the Polar Plunge.

In 2014, the Law Enforcement Torch Run® for Special Olympics Minnesota involved more than 1,200 law enforcement officers and personnel representing more than 100 agencies throughout the state. Their tremendous efforts raised over \$3.75 million for Special Olympics Minnesota.
